We will only have essential staff on site during this period and will continue to review the situation. We have implemented a plan to remove non-operational personnel to further protect the health of our team. Those who can perform their jobs from home and do not have to be in our offices, have begun to work from home to minimise any potential viral transmission.

On top of these measures, we will cut all call out fees and instead DRB Group will donate £75 per call out to local charities who need support during this period of uncertainty.

We are available to our existing customers or new business who need critical repairs – we also have the ability to deploy engineers from DRB Group to businesses in need if required.
